Grape varieties native

The Gaillac vineyard has a large number of grape varieties, some of which could be described as endemic. It is from these authentic and characterful grape varieties that the winegrowers of Gaillac are able to produce high quality wines.

RED WINES

Braucol
THE ORIGINAL

A typical grape variety of the South-West, better known as Fer Servadou. This grape variety produces colourful, full-bodied wines with aromas of red and black fruits (blackcurrant) and liquorice.

Dunas
THE ROOTED

The grape variety found only in Gaillac brings colour and finesse to the wines. Its very characteristic peppery aromas contribute strongly to the typicality of Gaillac red wines.

Prunelant
THE PHOENIX

One of the oldest Gaillac grape varieties, identified as the father of Malbec. It disappeared after the Phylloxera epidemic and was replanted 10 years ago. Today it is the source of a real craze and could become one of the spearheads of the vineyard. It is characterised by aromas of black fruits and prunes.

WHITE WINES

Mauzac
THE GAILLACOIS

Its name is thought to come from the Occitan term 'Maoussac', which referred to Moissac (a town in the Tarn-et-Garonne department). Here, people like to say that it is a Gaillac wine. It is characterised by aromas reminiscent of pear and green apple.

Loir de l'œil
THE QUIET STRENGTH

Also known as Len de l'El. It gets its name from the fact that the bunch is very far from the bud (eye) that gives rise to it. This grape variety produces fine wines with floral aromas of citrus and stone fruits (peach).

Ondenc
THE ELEGANT

This exceptional grape variety originates from the South-West of France. It is mainly found in the Gaillac vineyards. The Ondenc is vigorous and fertile, producing dry white wines of great finesse.

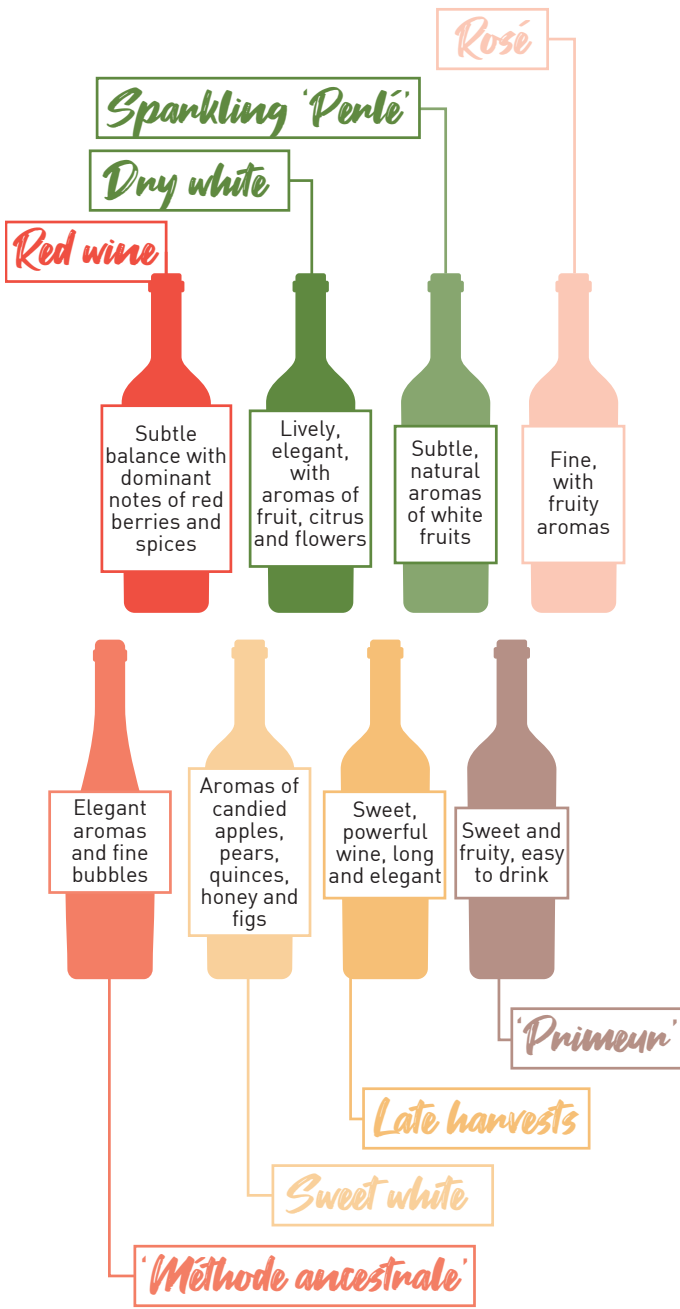

The Gaillac appellation covers three predominant terroirs:

PLATEAU CORDAIS

From Cahuzac-sur-Vère to the medieval town of Cordes sur Ciel, the Cordais plateau overlooks the Vère valley. This region is characterised by white limestone and stony soils.

RIVE DROITE

These hills stretch from Rabastens to the outskirts of Albi, passing through Lisle-sur-Tarn and Gaillac. Overlooking the entire Tarn valley, they are characterized by predominantly clay and limestone soils.

RIVE GAUCHE

This part runs along the banks of the Tarn and extends around the villages of Técou, Cadalen and Lagrave. The soil is made up of pebbles, gravel, sand or boulders.
